SPECIAL REGULATIONS & JUDGING GUIDELINES.

- 1 Decalitre = approximately ½ bushel.
- All entries to be variety tagged.
- Roots must be left attached on all grain sheafs.

CLASSES

- 1 ASW/APW Wheat, sheaf, for grain
- 2 Hard Wheat, sheaf, for grain
- 3 Two-row Barley, sheaf, for grain
- 4 Other Cereal Crop, sheaf, for grain
- 5 Narrow-leaf Lupins, sheaf, for grain
- 6 Canola, sheaf, for grain
- 7 Other Pulse Crop, sheaf, for grain
- 8 Hard Wheat, 1 decalitre
- 9 Two-row Barley, 1 decalitre
- 10 Narrow-leaf Lupins, 1 decalitre

DISTRICT GRAIN COMPETITION

Winning District holds the PONDEROSA ESTATE SHIELD (Trophy donated by L & D Olman).

2018 Winning District : Wongoondy

DISTRICTS : Devils Creek, North Mullewa, Pindar, Tenindewa, Tardun, Wongoondy, Casuarinas.

Must have at least 4-5 entries per class (per district), to be judged.

Each class attracts points 7 down to 1.

- a. Sheaf of wheat for grain
- b. Sheaf of canola for grain
- c. Sheaf of barley for grain
- d. Sheaf of white lupins for grain
- e. Sod of pasture

BIOMASS COMPETITION

The aim of this Category is to compare paddocks, rather than a single sheaf of crop, and give a true comparison of how paddocks are likely to yield. This will be done by Biomass Images being taken and assessed by CSBP. There is a very good correlation between crop biomass and yield and it is a good way to compare crops throughout the Mullewa region. Growers can enter into up to 3 grain sections.

CLASSES

- 11 Wheat
- 12 Lupins
- 13 Canola

There are two parts to the competition. To be eligible, growers need to register their paddocks at info@mullewashow.com.au prior to Sunday August 4th 2019, **AND supply a sample of the crop for a display on Show Day.**
