## **SPECIAL REGULATIONS & JUDGING GUIDELINES.**

- Character – Evenness of the crimp or wave, indicative of good breeding.
- Style – Term denoting a combination of the best attributes of wool character, good colour, softness, elasticity, tear and length.
- Robust – Term which implies vigour in reference to both wool and body, a term given to wool possessing more than the average amount of firmness and bulkiness for its type.
- Bulky or Dense – Wool closely packed on the sheep, all staples carrying a great number of fibres.
- Ram's fleeces to be skirted to broker's requirements
- All fleeces to be current season's clip and no more than 396 days growth of wool.
- Fleeces for Class 6 to be judged by multiplying weight by price per kilo as assessed by judge.

- 1 Merino Ram Fleece, Strong Wool
- 2 Merino Ram Fleece, Medium to Fine Wool
- 3 Merino Fleece, Strong Wool
- 4 Merino Fleece, Medium Wool
- 5 Merino Fleece, Fine Wool
- 6 Most Valuable Fleece (any)
- 7 Merino, 2 fleeces to be judged for evenness of type
- 8 Lamb's Wool, over 4cm, max length 55-60mm
- 9 Lamb's Wool, under 4cm
  
- 10 Zone 1 Fleece Competition : Entry to consist of 3 skirted fleeces of any breed.  
Winning entry entitled to compete in the Royal Zone Competition.
