- All exhibits must be grown by the Exhibitor
- All vegetables presented as for market (e.g. root vegetable with 2cm tops left on)
- All exhibits to be presented on a white disposable (plastic) plate
- Root vegetable to be cut when judged.
- Points will be awarded for presentation

- 1 Cabbage, any variety, 1 head
- 2 Cauliflower, 1 head
- 3 Lettuce, any variety, 1 head
- 4 Carrots, bunch of 3
- 5 Tomatoes, with stems attached, 4
- 6 Onions, bunch of 3
- 7 Potatoes, 3
- 8 Peas, 12 pods
- 9 Snow Peas, 12 Pods – Pea not developed
- 10 Sugar Snaps, 12 Pods – Pea developed in the pod
- 11 Beans, 12 pods
- 12 Radishes, bunch of 3
- 13 Spring Onions, bunch of 4, untrimmed
- 14 Silver beet, 6 leaves, judged on leaf
- 15 Rainbow Chard, 6 leaves, judged on stem length, colour and gloss of leaves
- 16 Pumpkin, any variety, 1
- 17 Broccoli, 1 head
- 18 Celery, 1 head, withhold leaves

- 20 Zucchini, 1
