

## ALL ENTRIES RECEIVED SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ROYAL AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY OF W.A.

First Prize.....	4 Points
Second Prize.....	2 Points
Sheep & Wool Section only : Champion.....	4 Points
Reserve Champion (Sheep).....	2 Points
Special Competitions First Prize.....	8 Points
Special Competitions Second Prize.....	6 Points

### REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS

- In all classes where there is a competition a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize will be awarded.
- Judges may withhold awards where entries are not of a sufficient standard.
- A judge may award a Highly Commended to any exhibitor thought worthy but not being awarded a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> prize.
- All sheep (unless otherwise stated) to be shown in the wool.
- All exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor, and the produce must be grown or made by the exhibitor, unless section or class states otherwise.
- The Executive committee reserves the right to reject or remove any exhibit, exhibitor, servant, attendant, or visitor from the grounds without assigning any reason for such decision.
- Exhibits will be received prior to Show Day by arrangement with the secretary only.
- Exhibits arriving after the time appointed may be accepted at the discretion of the stewards but not once judging has begun.
- All grain exhibits must be past season's growth.
- In cases of dispute as to the interpretation of any of the foregoing Rules and Regulations same shall be determined by the Executive Committee.
- Any person insulting or interfering with the judges during the show will be subject to removal from the grounds and all prizes shall be forfeited.
- It shall be the duty of the stewards to prevent any person from interfering with the judges and if necessary order the removal of the offender.
- All care is taken of exhibits but no responsibility will be incurred by the society. No exhibits will be insured at the society's expense.
- The society will not be held responsible for any accidents that may be caused by or from exhibits or exhibitors and it shall remain a condition of entry that the society shall remain blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident.
- Protests must be lodged at the Secretary's Office before 4pm on the day of the Show, accompanied by a fee of \$10 to be forfeited to Society if protest is deemed frivolous. No complaints will be dealt with after Show Day.
- Points will be allocated as follows: First – 4 points, Second – 2 points; Sheep and Wool section only: Champions – 4 points, Reserve Champion (sheep) - 2 points; Special Competitions as detailed in the Show Schedule: First – 8 points, Second – 6 points.
- In the event of a tie for a trophy, the winner shall be decided on a count back of firsts won.
- Exhibits are not to be removed until after 4.30pm on Show Day.
- The Executive Committee may demand a sworn declaration from farmers to Open Class.
- A Judge has the power to remove any exhibit entered in its wrong Class and place same in right class.
